A letter is being sent home this week and the reply slip will need to be returned with payment by **Friday 22nd November** for your child to be able to attend.

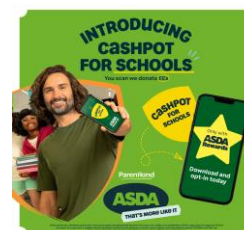


## Chocolate Tombola: Monday 16th December 3.15pm - 3.45pm
