Dear Parents and Carers,

Once again, Rogerthorpe Manor have very kindly offered to host our school Christmas Party free of charge. This year it will take place on Monday 15th December at 1.15p.m. – 3.15p.m.

As a school, we will walk to and from Rogerthorpe Manor. Rogerthorpe is one of our emergency evacuation points and so, in addition to attending the party, we will at the same time be able to practice evacuating the school. We have organised the number of adults accompanying each class in order to conform to appropriate adult/child ratios for off- site activities.

On the morning of the party, the children need to attend school in their school uniform and bring with them their party clothes to change into at lunchtime. Please note that all children need to be dressed appropriately for the walk both in terms of footwear and clothing i.e., rain coats, sensible shoes etc. We are able to store the children's outdoor shoes when they reach Rogerthorpe Manor, so, if your child's party shoes are not suitable for walking down Badsworth Way, they will need to carry their indoor shoes with them. Therefore, please ensure your child has a bag to carry their party shoes for the walk.

The children will return to school in time to be picked up as normal. Because this is a local trip and an evacuation point, it is not our intention to send out permission slips for this event. If, however, you would prefer your child not to attend, please contact school in order for alternative provision to be organised.
