Last week, Year 6 had a visit to Tropical World linking to our science and geography work. In the morning, we did a workshop. This was called 'Eat or be Eaten' where we learnt about adaptations and food chains. One of the things we did in this workshop was dress up as some Amazon animals. We studied their bodies to learn about how they have adapted to their tropical environment. The chameleon's tail helps it grip onto branches. Its head shape also allows water to drip down into its mouth for drinking. Then, in the afternoon, we got to go into Tropical World Centre. We saw many different species from reptiles, fish and mammals such as piranhas, monkeys and meercats – and even a crocodile!
