Thank you to everyone who took part and bought tickets for our Easter Hamper raffle. This raised **£158** for FOBS.

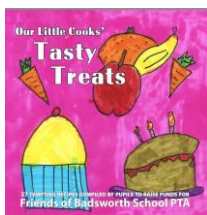
Upcoming Events
