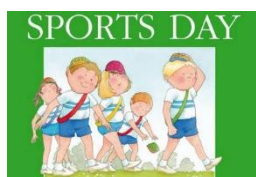

Dear Parent / Carers,

Please see below the information for Sports Day and Fun Day. Obviously, it is weather permitting, so we are hoping for a good day. As you will appreciate, the unpredictable nature of our British weather makes it difficult to know too far in advance what may happen but we are remaining hopeful!

Foundation Stage & Key Stage 1 -Sport Day 9:15a.m. School start time is as normal and, after dropping children off in the usual way, parents/carers may go straight down onto the school field.

Key Stage 2 – Sports Day 1.20p.m.- The school gate will be opened at 1:10p.m. to allow parents/carers to make their way to the school field.

There will be a limited number of chairs out for visitors so you may wish to bring a folding chair.

All parents/carers – Children are required to come to school in their full PE kit – navy blue shorts and white polo t-shirt. Also, correct footwear (trainers) is particularly important.



Children should also have sun hats and water bottles. Please ensure that you have also applied sun cream to your child before school. Staff members are unable to apply sun cream to pupils.



At the end of KS2 Sports Day, children must be collected from their classrooms in the usual way. This is particularly important as hopefully many will be staying for Fun Day. Could parents/carers please inform school if your school bus children are not travelling home by bus on this afternoon, as well as cancelling their place on the bus.

FUN DAY - Stalls, Games, Refreshments – will commence as soon as possible after KS2 Sports Day finishes. This usually starts about 3pm. EYFS & KS1 children will be released earlier if adults are here to collect.

Year 6 Stalls – Our Year 6 children are busy organising stalls for the children to take part in at Fun Day. This money goes to school fund. These will be charged at around 20p, 50p or £1 a go. To help us out, **could we please ask that you bring change** to take part in these events.



FOBS will be serving refreshments at both Sports Days. Tea, coffee, cold drinks and sweet treats will be sold throughout the day. For a reduced price, bring your own refillable cup. This year, FOBS will be selling bacon sandwiches throughout the morning (EYFS&KS1).

Hot dogs and ice-creams will be sold at Fun Day from the window of TJ's Room.
