Excellent effort Foundation Stage, you have certainly added to a bright future for the Air Ambulance and believed you can make a difference to the lives of others.



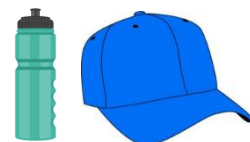
Year 1 & 2 Visit to a Synagogue
